The November Annual Session is scheduled as planned to be in person, in Augusta, Georgia. We are still watching and collecting data on how to proceed with all events and meetings. Please stay tuned to any information that is sent for the betterment of the convention as a body.

As we move through this season, it is my goal to ensure that every constituent of this body of believers is up to date on things to come.

As President I believe in transparency and desire for everyone to be informed about what is going on with our beloved convention. Communication is a critical part of GMBC being successful.
