Seminars are taught only at the Annual Session in November. Individuals taking these seminars will receive a Certificate of Completion and not the SSPB Certified Accreditation Card.

To receive a Certificate of Completion, students must attend and complete one of the seminar courses entirely.

SEMINARS

CL0014 Christian Education In Church Growth

INSTRUCTOR: Rev. Mark Seals

This course is designed to lead the Christian educator in evaluating and assessing growth through Christian education. Students will develop a plan for growing the church through effective Christian education programs.

CL0022 Evangelism Guided By The Holy Spirit


INSTRUCTOR: Rev. Al Robinson

Course Offerings

Please select one of the following courses. Note: You must take Part A of the course, which was offered at the February 2021 Adjourned Session, and Part B, which is offered at the Annual Session to get full credit for the course. Delegates who did not attend a course during the February 2021 Adjourned Session may select one of the seminars listed in this brochure.

1003—Translations and Versions of the Bible

Instructor: Dr. Albertine Marshall

This course will investigate the methods and procedures used to produce the many translations and versions. Textbook: *History of the Bible in English*, Bruce, Oxford Press

1072—Survey of the New Testament

Instructor: Dr. Carol Rich

This course will engage in a general overview of the divisions, time periods, places, events, people, and archaeology of the New Testament sections of the Bible. Textbook: *Survey of the New Testament*, Paul Benware, Moody

3008—Theology and History of Christianity (COPP)

Instructor: Dr. Leon Ward

This course will outline the development of the Christian movement from the beginning of Jesus' ministry on earth to present times. Students will focus on the history, theology, culture, and times that enable Christianity to develop and grow. Prominent persons who impacted the Christian movement will be identified. Textbook: *Story of The Christian Church*, Jesse Hurlbut, Zondervan

4014—The Doctrine of Prayer

Instructor: Dr. Donald Porter

This course will teach the fundamental purpose, principles, and power of prayer. Understand prayer as the channel of communication of the believer to the Father. Textbook: *Understanding the Purpose and Power of Prayer: How to Call Heaven to Earth*, Dr. Myles Monroe,

7010—Introduction to Discipleship (COPP)

Instructor: Rev. Ronald Gantt

This course is designed to introduce the believer to the biblical principle of discipleship. The course will examine the character traits of believers, while looking at the overall examples of Jesus. Students will study discipleship methods of Jesus and the difference between discipleship and membership. Textbook: *Spiritual Discipleship*, J. Oswald Sanders, Moody Publishers

9008—Public Speaking

Instructor: Minister Joice Tinsley

This course will identify the process and principles for writing speeches and delivering them in public. It will relay basic verbal and nonverbal communications skills to enable the students to effectively communicate with audiences of all sizes. (Teacher Certification Requirement) Textbook: *Dos and Taboos of Public Speaking*, Axtell Wiley
